Under the Direction of the Miss Rodeo Nebraska Association, Inc.

- A. Contestant must not be less than 14, nor more than 17 years of age as of the first day of the contest. Contestant must be a permanent resident of the State of Nebraska and must live at home with a parent or legal guardian during her reign or maintain her legal address with parent or legal guardian. Contestant must provide a copy of her birth certificate. Contestant is a citizen of the United States of America.
- B. Gender, Contestant is female and has always been female.
- C. Contestant is currently enrolled in a high school in the State of Nebraska.
- D. Contestant is in good health and does not have any health concerns which would prevent full participation in this contest or from serving as Miss Teen Rodeo Nebraska if selected.
- E. Contestant is not currently married and has never been married. If she should marry or become pregnant, the title will go to the first runner-up and she will forfeit all prizes and monies received from the Pageant and during her reign as Miss Teen Rodeo Nebraska. All of the above will be returned to the Miss Rodeo Nebraska Association, Inc Executive Board in like new condition.
- F. Contestant is not a parent of any child and she is not and has never been pregnant nor terminated a pregnancy.
- G. Contestant is of good moral character, has never committed or been involved in an act of moral turpitude, crime or misdemeanor, excluding minor traffic offenses, nor has she had a title removed for any reason.
- H. Contestant does not use illegal or controlled substances (other than prescription medications and then only in the manner prescribed.) Contestant does not abuse alcohol or other dangerous substances.
- I. Contestant will have executed all required consents and/or waivers of liability prior to the competition.
- J. Contestant hereby grants permission to the Miss Rodeo Nebraska Pageant Committee/Miss Rodeo Nebraska Association, Inc. to verify any and all information contained on her application and attests that the information she has provided is true.
- K. Contestant is subject to a public records search prior to her application being accepted by the Miss Rodeo Nebraska Pageant Committee, including an internet search. Contestant agrees to a social media search. Contestant consents to a background check, if deemed necessary.
- L. Contestant is not under any contractual obligations which would interfere with her ability to participate in this contest or interfere with her ability to perform as Miss Teen Rodeo Nebraska, if selected.
- M. It is the duty and obligation of anyone in a competition of this status to portray the highest of moral and ethical standards, show the true ideals of young womanhood and set an example above reproach.
- N. Contestant must agree to abide by Pageant rules with the possibility of disqualification for infractions.
- O. If you hold a title when competing for the title of Miss Teen Rodeo Nebraska, the following requirements must be met: It is the Contestant's responsibility to contact the committee of whom she holds the crown and obtain a letter of approval from that committee to be able to compete in the Miss Teen Rodeo Nebraska Pageant. This letter is due on April 1st, the contest deadline. If the Contestant should win the title of Miss Teen Rodeo Nebraska, she will represent the title of Miss Teen Rodeo Nebraska in all state appearances with the exception of that previous title's rodeo. The newly crowned Miss Teen Rodeo Nebraska will have until October 1st of the same year to crown her successor. All decisions are made at the discretion of the Executive Board of the Miss Rodeo Nebraska Association, Inc.
- P. No Other Acts Detrimental to Reputation: Contestant has not engaged in any act, which if made public, would be reasonably likely to cause harm or damage to Contestant's reputation or to the goodwill and reputation of Miss Rodeo Nebraska Association, Inc. including any and all social networking sites and/or any internet sites. (If Contestant has any concerns about the applicability of this provision, Contestant acknowledges she has been advised to discuss this with a representative of Miss Rodeo Nebraska Association, Inc. prior to signing this form.)

CONTESTANT AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT is made between the Miss Rodeo Nebraska Pageant, in the City of North Platte, Nebraska, hereinafter referred to as "Pageant" and _____, of _____ (city) Nebraska, hereinafter referred to as "Contestant".

WHEREAS, Contestant desires to compete in the Pageant,

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises set forth herein, the mutual benefits derived here from and other good and valuable consideration provided each unto the other, the receipt and sufficiency of which is acknowledged by delivery hereof, it is agreed:

Contestant represents she (a) has read all Pageant rules and regulations; (b) has received a complete copy of all Pageant rules and regulations; (c) has otherwise been fully advised as to any and all written and/or verbal amendments, if any, to Pageant rules and/or regulations; (d) understands each and every rule and/or regulation, and (e) had full opportunity to present all questions regarding the rules and regulations, and all such questions have been fully answered.

1. Contestant will adhere to and comply with all Contest rules and regulations.
2. The Pageant shall, upon observing or being informed of any violation of and/or perceived violation of any Pageant rule and/or regulation:
 - a. Contestant of the alleged and/or perceived violation at the earliest and most proximate time to the instance, but in no event, not to be less than five hours of the scheduled naming of the contest winner(s) and
 - b. In no way act to withhold information as to deprive the Pageant of the opportunity to determine alleged violations. In this regard, Miss Rodeo Nebraska National Director, a Miss Rodeo Nebraska Pageant Committee member selected by the National Director and one teen Contestant parent who will be selected at orientation are hereby designated as the Grievance Committee and will receive any and all alleged and/ or perceived rule violation(s).
3. Unless timely reported as defined above in paragraph 3(a), each and every alleged violation of and/or perceived violation of the Pageant rules and/or regulations shall be deemed waived and the complaining party shall be stopped from presenting allegations regarding the same.
4. The Pageant agrees that, with respect to reported violation(s), it shall (a) timely and fully investigate each allegation; (b) report its findings to the person presenting the allegation and (c) enforce the rules and regulations any Contestant found to have violated the same.
5. Contestant agrees that the Pageant is the sole and exclusive entity to determine the existence and/or nonexistence of a violation of the rules and regulations and that Contestant shall be bound by the Pageant's determination, the same to be final and binding between the parties hereto. Contestant further agrees that the Pageant is the sole and exclusive authority to interpret and enforce its rules and regulations.
6. In any legal proceeding in which the Pageant will be awarded any judgment enforcing any term and/or condition of this Agreement, the Pageant, its employees, agents, sponsors and/or representatives shall also receive reasonable attorney fees and all costs incurred in the prosecution and/or defense of said action.
